




eyes wide open (an expression)

- to have a clear understanding of the reality of a situation, to be fully aware of a situation


e.g. I accepted the very difficult job with my eyes wide open.









NO ENTRY

I am a child. You have no right to touch me, to sell me, to buy me. Stay away from me.




I was groomed alone and vulnerable gifts when I was sad when I was 12 everything changed I was sold every day completely controlled my life nobody noticed
