This exhibition explores Haringey's own heritage and evidence of local Black presence relating to the slave trade from the 16th century. It acknowledges the significant contribution of the extra-parliamentary popular movement against the trade by local Quakers and others from the 1780s onwards; creating a context for us all to understand and examine the legacy of the slave trade we live with today.
