
Two girls, 15 and 17 years old, were checking in...




Two passengers seem to be travelling together on a flight, but one person appears to be in control of the other.

Everything is probably fine, however, several signs suggest that perhaps something is 'NOT right'.






SIGNS OF POSSIBLE HUMAN TRAFFICKING: Airports and flights
